What to pack

The Swedish summer weather can vary a great deal; from 10°C and rain, to 30°C and bright sunshine. It is therefore a good idea to bring cloths and equipment that can handle different kinds of weather conditions. We have tried to put together a list for you on what to bring as your personal equipment, adjusted to Swedish camp conditions.

Sleeping equipment

- € Sleeping bag *Note that temperature may be as low as 10°C at night*
- € Nightwear

Hygiene articles

- € Toothbrush
- € Toothpaste
- € Soap
- € Shampoo
- € Towel
- € Sun block / sunscreen
- € First aidkit

Clothes

- € Scout shirt with badges,
- € Navy cargo trousers/shorts or navy skirt or smart navy trousers.
- € UK necker
- € Underwear
- € Shorts
- € Sandals
- € Sun hat
- € Mittens / gloves
- € Warm socks
- € Warm shirts
- € Long trousers
- € Windproof jacket
- € A full set of waterproofs (jacket and trousers)
- € Walking boots

Other items

- € Passport
- € Money belt/wallet
- € Water bottle
- € Flashlight / torch (plus extra batteries)
- € Swimwear

Do not bring

- Music player with loudspeakers
- Pen knife
